AGrapher is designed to work in Windows 3.1 using standard VGA mode with the assumption that screen pixels are square. On some monitors this is not the case, and you will have to adjust the scales to make circles draw as circles not as ellipses. If you want to print a graph, you will have to go back to an "equal" scale to have the printing work correctly.
