Minimal system requirements:

IBM-compatible PC 386 DX 25, VGA graphics adapter with 256 colours in a resolution of 640 to 480 pixels, MS-Windows (tm) 3.1, 4 MB RAM, soundcard **strongly** recommended.

ATTENTION!!!

Before starting the program will check if all of its files are present and unchanged. You should **not** delete or alter any file and by this lose your working copy of TZ-Breakout. We do **not** provide any disks to anybody without extra charges, otherwise the price of the program would have to be much higher.

By checking itself the program is sure to be hundred percent executable and undamaged. So, if you hopefully register, it will work to your pleasure. Please make a backup of this program.

VGA-graphics adapter problems

Our painful experience has shown that most Windows-user do **not** use the capabilities of their graphics adapter under Windows but seem to be content with sixteen colours only. Even if this seems to be enough for them it definitely is **not** enough for our programs.

If you installed Windows using the standard installation routines it will use the standard VGA-device driver capable to display only 16 colours. Our programs will complain about this, even though they will not refuse to work - offering weird (mostly red and grey) colour mixtures instead.

Together with your graphics adapter you should have gotten a disk with device drivers for Windows. These have to be installed properly according to your VGA-graphics adapter manual.

If your graphics adapter manual does **not** ask you to make a backup of all the files with the ending .INI then here **we** do. Otherwise implementing a new device driver might sometimes force you to install Windows again.

After installment you might (together with good graphic adapters) find a new program icon on your Windows screen to adjust your graphics adapter. If your graphics adapter does not contain this feature you will have to start the program **Windows Setup** inside the main group of the program manager. Please choose **change system setups** from the **options** menu. Choose the device suitable for your graphics adapter with at least 256 colours (we recommend to use small fonts). If all this is done you will have to restart Windows... and enjoy our game.

If you didn't choose the right device driver or (as unfortunately often is the case with cheap adapters) it is not working correctly you will have to copy all the *.INI files back to the Windows directory (you did a backup of them, didn't you?).

How can I turn a registered version into an unregistered version to give to all my friends?

If you are a registered user you are allowed to give **all** of the files to everybody you like except the file BREAKOUT.SNR. This file contains your serial number and it is unlawful to give this file to anybody. Please make a backup of this file and/or write down your serial number on a piece of paper.
