FAQ

Question: When I run Desktop Architect with Window Blinds it blows up?

Answer: You must add da.exe to your Window Blinds exclusion list. This has been tested as of Window Blinds 0.90 and it still has a problem.

Question: When I run Desktop Architect with Norton Utilities my desktop icons do not always show correctly? **Answer:** Norton Utilities creates icon overlays for the recycle bin in a non-standard fashion. Desktop Architect does not recognize the change.

Question: I installed a theme I downloaded using the Install Wizard but it cannot find all of the files.

Answer: Unfortunately every theme is not distributed the same way. Desktop Architect does a thorough search to locate all of the files listed in the theme, but occasionally either it is not located near the theme or the author forgot to add it.

Question: I selected a theme but the colors are all messed up, how do I fix it?

Answer: Please be sure that you are running in at least 16 bit color mode (32768 colors or higher). You can check your settings in the display control panel applet.

Question: Can you add in support for additional system icons such as folders and control panel?

Answer: This is actually being considered for a future release post 1.0.
