

A vast amount of science (and scientific ideas) is embedded within COLORTRON, but you do not need to understand all of this science to use COLORTRON effectively. Nevertheless, you may wish to explore the science behind COLORTRON. The manual provides many avenues for exploration; this Glossary is one such avenue. For those already familiar with the terms used here, this Glossary serves as a ready reference, especially for those terms specific to COLORTRON.

Many entries included here refer to terms used in the *Color and Measurement Primer*. Others are meant to provide additional information not found in the Primer. This Glossary defines terms you may encounter in the COLORTRON software, elsewhere in this manual, or in the color science literature. Some entries are not general color science terms at all but are specific to certain contexts, such as COLORTRON or the Macintosh. Such definitions are indicated
