

Using PowerBar's Special Commands

PowerBar provides a number of what are called Special Commands. As described above, most of these commands are PowerBar's version of typical Finder menu options.

The following is a list of the special commands available (with notes where applicable):

- Open Selection
- Print Selection
- Make Alias of Selection (AliasBOSS)
- Duplicate Selection
- Get Info for Selection
- Put Selection Away
- Put Macintosh To Sleep*
- Find - opens the "Find" dialog
- Place Selection Into Trash
- Empty Trash
- Restart Macintosh
- Shutdown Macintosh
- Change File Sharing Settings
- Make New Folder
- Run A QuicKey
- Eject Disk
- Erase Disk
- Undo Text
- Cut Text
- Copy Text
- Paste Text
- Clear Text
- Show Clipboard

- Select All
- About This Macintosh
- Turn Balloon Help On/Off
- Hide Other (non-Finder) Applications
- Cleanup Front Most Window (or Desktop)
- Placeholder - Use this as a separator button

* The Put Mac To Sleep command will NOT invoke a screen-saver (some of which may put a "Sleep" menu option into the Finder's Special menu). It only invokes the "sleep" mode of PowerBooks and Portables.
