Using WindowBOSS

WindowBOSS is a feature of PowerBar that lets you select windows of any open application by means of a hierarchical menu attached to the Application menu. Additionally, if the application you're inspecting is the front most, the window menu you see will have a further item, Stack Windows, which permits you to do just that. This option will only be available to the active application which must have at least two windows open. Otherwise you won't even see the menu option. Note that the windows are not resized in any way. They are simply stacked to the left of your screen.

WindowBOSS also lets you cycle through active applications by using the keyboard. The keys utilized to accomplish this feat can be changed via the WindowBOSS Preferences dialog opened in the control panel. You also have the option to hide an application's windows when it is switched "out". Simply click the checkbox in the WindowBOSS Preferences that indicates whether or not to "Hide Windows When Switching".

Note that you can also turn off WindowBOSS completely if you choose not to use it (as is true with most of the additional features of PowerBar).
