Install the Windows 95 Dial-Up Networking

- 1 Double-click the My Computer icon on your desktop. If you do not see a Dial-Up Networking icon, then follow steps 2 through 4.
- 2 Click here  to display Add/Remove Programs.
- 3 Click the Windows Setup tab.
- 4 Click Communications, and then click Details.
- 5 Check Dial-Up Networking, and then click OK.

What's next?


- Dial-Up networking is installed. Install TCP/IP.

Install the Windows 95 TCP/IP protocol

- 1 Click here  to display Network properties.
- 2 Add. (If the Windows 95 TCP/IP protocol is already installed, you can go to step 6.)
- 3 Click Protocol, and then click Add.
- 4 Click Microsoft, and then click TCP/IP.
- 5 Click OK.
- 6 Click Dial-Up Adapter, and then click Properties. Or, if your organization has a direct Internet connection, click your network adapter, and then click Properties.
- 7 Click the Bindings tab, and then make sure the TCP/IP check box is checked. Then click OK.
- 8 Click OK.

If prompted, restart your computer.
