

This table summarizes some of the features available when printing in FrameMaker. The features are listed with brief explanations.

**Table 1: Printing**

<b>Feature</b>		<b>Notes</b>
<b>Print Page Range</b>	<b>All</b>	Prints all pages in a document.
	<b>Start Page</b>	The number of the first page to print.
	<b>End Page</b>	The number of the last page to print.
<b>Printer Paper Size<sup>1</sup></b>	<b>Width</b>	8-1/2" for US Letter and US Legal; 8-1/4" for A4 letter; 7" for B5 Letter.
	<b>Height</b>	11" for US Letter; 14" for US Legal; 11-2/3" for A4 Letter; 10" for B4 Letter.
<b>Scale</b>		Percentage reduction or enlargement. FrameMaker centers the page image on the paper.
<b>Page Order</b>	<b>Odd-Numbered Pages</b>	Prints odd-numbered pages. Default is on.
	<b>Even-Numbered Pages</b>	Prints even-numbered pages. Default is on.
	<b>Two-sided</b>	To print on both sides of the paper: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Print odd-numbered pages only.</li> <li>2. When FrameMaker finishes printing, turn the pages over and put them in the printer tray so they will print on the other side.</li> <li>3. Print even-numbered pages only.</li> </ol>
	<b>Collate</b>	If you print several copies, turn this on to print each copy separately.
	<b>Last Sheet First</b>	If pages come out of your printer with the printed side up, turn this on so the top page is page one.

<sup>1</sup> For landscape documents, reverse the values used for width and height.
