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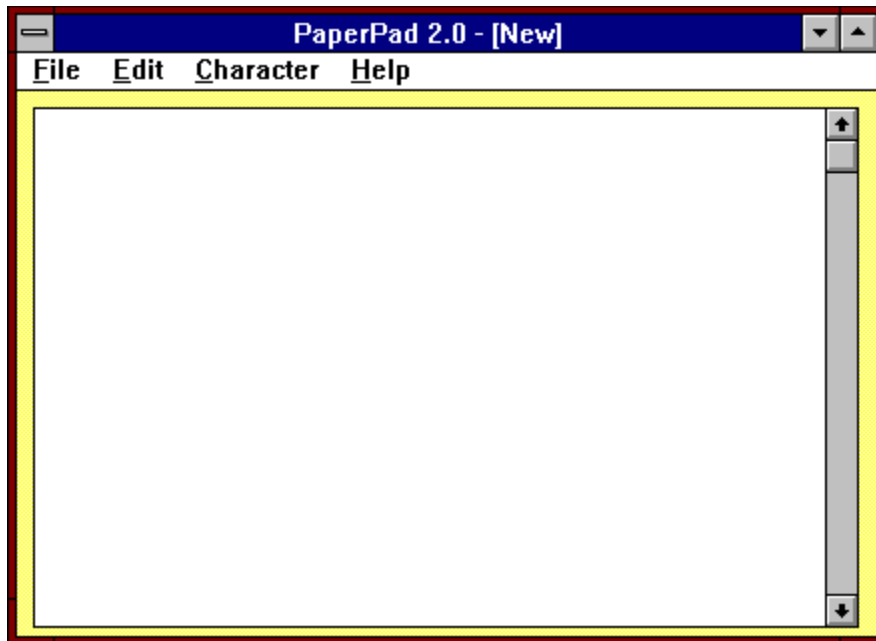

WIN.INI Settings

For those Power Users who like to know what ever little setting and possible change in their Windows Initialization file, we have strove to show what possible things PaperPad could do to your WIN.INI. Below is the PaperPad and XpresWare sections of the file:

[XpresWare]
PadPath=C:\WINDOWS\
```

[PaperPad]
HelpPath=C:\WINDOWS\
SaveDFIt?=1
TextBox=0
Font=Arial
Size=12
```

The *XpresWare* section is for the benefit of other XpresWare programs. It states the location of their executable file (.EXE), for instance if you have Easy Out on your system, the line *EOPath=* is added. The *PaperPad* section, however, is slightly more complex:

HelpPath is where this help file is located.

SaveDFIt? decides whether the font and font size are saved at exit (1 means yes, 0 means no).

TextBox decides whether the Text Information Box is open. (1 means yes, 0 means no).

Font is the last used font.

Size is the size of last used font.

Most of these settings can be modified in the *Options...* dialog box.



For users of earlier versions of PaperPad, this new release probably resembles your version to such an extent that you are probably saying "So, what's so new about this?"

Well, here is the answer:

- Options are now grouped together in a single dialog box!
- Search and replace functions!
- Undo function!
- Save As... and Save are separate!
- Search from the Help menu!
- Edit and read files up to 60 kilobytes!
- New icon!
- No messy problems regarding the location of the WIN.INI!
- Better clipboard control!
- Print the text using the settings on screen!



File Menu

<u>F</u> ile	<u>E</u> dit	<u>F</u> ormat
<u>N</u> ew	Ctrl+N

The File menu controls general file input/output with *Open...* and *Save [As...]* commands, along with printing, creating new files, and exiting the program.

This chart should help to make what the specific commands in the File menu are:

	If you choose this option.....this is what happens
<u>N</u> ew	Clears the editing area for a new file. If text is displayed that has changed since last being save, the program prompts for a save.
<u>O</u> pen...	Brings up the <i>Open File...</i> dialog box, which prompts you to choose the file to open. After the file opens, it is displayed in the edit window, and the file name is displayed on the title bar in the syntax "PaperPad 2.0 - <i>filename</i> ". If there was text displayed in the edit window, then the program prompts you to save.
<u>S</u> ave	Saves the current text to the text's filename (the <i>filename</i> part of "PaperPad 2.0 - <i>filename</i> "). If the file has not yet been previously saved, then the <i>Save As...</i> dialog box appears.
Save <u>A</u> s...	Brings up the <i>Save As...</i> dialog box, which prompts you to enter the filename to which the text currently displayed in the edit window will be saved to. The title bar of the program will then change from whatever it used to be to "PaperPad 2.0 - <i>filename</i> ."
<u>P</u> rint	Prints the text in the edit window. When this option is chosen, the program pauses to print (there is no background printing).
<u>E</u> xit	Quits PaperPad 2.0. If the text in the edit window has changed since it was last saved, then the program asks you if you wish to save, and if you choose yes, brings up the <i>Save As...</i> dialog box.

The Edit menu controls all the editing commands, like cutting and pasting text, and finding and replacing specific strings of text.

If you choose this.....This happens

<u>U</u> ndo	The program undoes the most recent action, such as adding or deleting text.
<u>C</u> ut	The program cuts the selected text to the clipboard.
<u>C</u> opy	The program copies the selected text to the clipboard.
<u>P</u> aste	The program pastes whatever the clipboard currently contains into the edit window of PaperPad.
<u>D</u> elete	The selected text in the edit window is deleted, recoverable only if <i>Undo</i> is clicked.
<u>S</u> earch...	The <u>Search... dialog box</u> is displayed, which allows you to enter the string of text that you wish to find.
<u>A</u> gain	The last search is repeated.
<u>O</u> ptions...	The <u>Options... dialog box</u> is displayed, which allows you to choose whether to view the <u>Text Information box</u> , to save the font and size at exit, and to enter where the program executable (PPAD.EXE) and help file (this one, PPAD.HLP).

Character Menu



This menu contains the formatting codes designed to make the text look more attractive to you, or if you wish to write in a different language that does not use the Latin characters, like Greek or Chinese, for instance.

If you choose this.....This happens

<u>F</u> ont	A sub menu opens that displays your fonts, either all of them or the first twenty, whichever is less.
Form <u>a</u> t	A sub menu opens that displays five options: Normal, Bold, Italic, Underline, Strikethru. If you choose Normal then all the other formatting is removed (no bold, no italic...).
<u>S</u> ize	A sub menu opens that displays the even font sizes between 8 and 20 points.
<u>O</u> ptions...	The <i>Font Options</i> dialog box is opened. It allows you to do everything on the other menu choices, but includes all fonts.



Help Menu



This drop-down menu has the controls to launch WinHelp with the PaperPad 2.0 help file (this is it!), the "Help on Help" file, and the About box.

If you choose this.....	This happens
<u>I</u> ndex	This file is opened, with the Contents (index) displayed. Please note that the program must know where the help file is, so you must enter the correct location in the <i>Options</i> dialog box (see the Edit Menu).
<u>S</u> earch...	The WinHelp's <i>Search</i> dialog box will open, allowing you to find whatever topic you have a question on. Once again, the program must know where the help file is.
<u>H</u> elp on Help	WinHelp launches the main windows helpfile.
<u>A</u> bout....	The About... dialog box is displayed.

The only shortcut key for the Help menu is F1, which launches the Index.
